





# The Bike Display

In conjunction with the 2024 Chief Blackhawk Davenport Meet, the motorcycle show will be held in the EXPO BUILDING. Please note the following:

#### **ELIGIBLE MOTORCYCLES**

As before, all motorcycles, scooters, 3-wheelers & minibikes 35 Years old and older may be entered. This year's theme is Military.

#### **EXPO BUILDING**

To allow convenient viewing of the show bikes and minimize traffic tie-ups and congestion, we will have the motorcycle display in the EXPO BUILDING. During the day the Side garage door (near the grandstands) will be open to bring your bikes in for display. The Expo building will be CLOSED AND LOCKED EACH NIGHT. No motorcycles will be allowed to enter or leave the building except during open display hours.

Watch for signs directing you to the entrance and sign-in.

#### **SHOW HOURS**

Entries welcome starting Wednesday morning at 8:00 AM, continuing through Saturday at 9 AM. Bikes must be registered & tagged at the door when entering the display building. Display is open from 8 AM to 5 PM Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday, and 8 AM to 2 PM Saturday. Building WILL BE CLOSED & LOCKED EACH NIGHT – No motorcycles will be allowed to enter or leave the building, except during open display hours.

#### **SIMPLIFIED REGISTRATION**

Motorcycle & Owner information will be gathered using a SINGLE HANDLE BAR TAG. This tag will include the tear-off CLAIM CHECK portion, as well as the Registration number used for identification and awards voting.

#### **AWARDS TIMES**

The announcement of awards will be at 1 PM Saturday. Our display committee will identify and select award recipients on Saturday morning between 9 and 11 A.M. ONLY Bikes still in the display building Saturday before 9 A.M. will be eligible for awards.

# Lodging

#### At the Fairgrounds:

The fair board is in charge of any and all lodging done at the fairgrounds itself, and can be reached at: http://www.mvfair.com/

Any questions about camping or electricity, please contact the Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds at (563)326-5338.

Chief Blackhawk does not have any involvement in camping with regards to hook ups and fees. Any questions or issues should be taken up with the fairgrounds.

#### At West Lake:

#### **Hotels/Motels:**

All accommodations are a minimum of 3 miles from the fairgrounds. Walking is only viable if camping at the fairgrounds.

Because we all live here, we don't have much knowledge of the local accommodations, so no recommendations from this quarter. The area is very small compared to most folks idea of a city, so getting around is not really a problem. Nothing in the lowa area is more than 15 minutes away from the swap meet, and nothing on the Illinois side is more than 25 minutes from the swap meet. Newer hotels can be found on Elmore Ave., and Utica Ridge in Davenport, IA.

For a reasonably complete list of hotels and motels in the area try this link: http://www.visitquadcities.com/. Select "Visitors" the "Hotels & Motels" under Lodging, on the right of the drop down menu.

The Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds has a fee for hooking up electricity in your vending area, if electricity is available. You can sign up for electrical at the meet or let Vending Registration know ahead of time. Leave your name and space number at the registration table, and the fairgrounds will come around to your space to hook up if available. The fairgrounds is responsible for hook up. Vendors must be in their spot when they come to hook up electricity. Chief Blackhawk does not make available or set fees for electrical hook up. Any questions on availability and fee please see the fairgrounds personnel.

You MUST clean up after your pets or leave them at home. No exotic pets allowed. Dogs must be on a leash.

We do have security from local police departments on the grounds if you should have any problems, they will be making rounds on a golf cart, or you can come to registration for assistance in getting them.


#### Join Chief Blackhawk




