This Year's Field Games



1. Slow Race

Format: Bracket Style, Single Elimination **Objective:** Be the first to cross the finish line without touching the ground outside your lane.

How It Works:

- Players compete head-to-head in one-on-one matchups inside two painted lanes.
- The goal is to move as slowly as possible—this is the opposite of a normal race!
- The first player to cross the finish line OR the first to step outside their lane (onto the grass) loses.
- The winner moves on to the next round.



2. Rope Wind

Format: Individual, Length-based Scoring **Objective:** Wind as much rope around the barrel as possible without touching the ground.

How It Works:

- Each player grabs onto a long rope (200 feet) that's tied to a weighted barrel.
- They must ride or run in circles around the barrel, winding the rope as they go.
- If the player's feet touch the ground, they must stop, and the spot is marked with a bandana.
- The person who winds the most rope (i.e., makes the most revolutions) wins.



3. Potato Sack Obstacle Race

Format: Bracket Style **Objective:** Be the first to finish the obstacle course while hopping or weaving through obstacles.

How It Works:

- The course includes cones or potato sacks placed in a zigzag pattern along lanes.
- Players must hop (using sacks) or weave through the course (using cones) and stay in their lane.
- The first to cross the finish line wins.



4. Weenie Bite

Format: One Player at a Time **Objective:** Bite off the largest piece of a suspended hot dog while riding beneath it.

How It Works:

- A hot dog (weenie) is suspended by string, hanging in the air.
- Each player rides under it, either by: riding solo, or having a partner push or carry them (piggyback style).
- The player tries to bite as much as they can out of the hot dog—hands-free.
- Whoever takes the biggest bite wins.



5. Rodeo-Style Barrel Race

Format: Timed Individual Race **Objective:** Weave around all barrels in a triangle formation as fast as possible.

How It Works:

- One person competes at a time.
- Three barrels are set up in a large triangle, spaced widely apart.
- Riders must weave around each barrel in the designated pattern (usually a cloverleaf or figure-eight path).
- The fastest time wins.



6. Keg Roll

Format: Individual or Group Race **Objective:** Roll the keg or barrel down the lane using your motorcycle and cross the finish line first.

How It Works:

- Each player uses a motorcycle to push or roll a keg/barrel down a marked lane.
- If the keg rolls outside the lane, the player must correct its course without leaving their own lane.
- The first player to cross the finish line with their keg wins.

The Bike Display

In conjunction with the 2026 Chief Blackhawk Davenport Meet, the Motorcycle Display will be held in the Expo Building.

Please note the following:

ELIGIBLE MOTORCYCLES

As before, all motorcycles, scooters, three-wheelers, and minibikes 35 years old or older may be entered.

This year's theme celebrates British motorcycles.

EXPO BUILDING

To allow convenient viewing of the show bikes and minimize traffic tie-ups and congestion, we will have the motorcycle display in the EXPO BUILDING. During the day, the Side Garage Door (near the grandstands) will be open to bring your bikes in for display. The Expo Building will be CLOSED AND LOCKED EACH NIGHT. No motorcycles will be allowed to enter or leave the building, except during open display hours.

Watch for signs directing you to the entrance and sign-in.

SHOW HOURS

Entries will be accepted beginning **Thursday at 8:00 AM** and continuing through **Saturday at 9:00 AM**.

Bikes must be registered & tagged at the door when entering the display building.

The display is open:

THURSDAY: 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

FRIDAY: 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

SATURDAY: 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Building WILL BE CLOSED & LOCKED EACH NIGHT –

No motorcycles will be allowed to enter or leave the building, except during open display hours.

SIMPLIFIED REGISTRATION

Motorcycle and owner information will be gathered using a Single Handlebar Tag. This tag will include the tear-off CLAIM CHECK portion, as well as the registration number used for identification and awards voting.

AWARDS TIMES

Awards will be announced at 1:00 PM on Saturday. Our display committee will identify and select award recipients on Saturday morning between 9:00 and 11:00 AM. Only motorcycles in the display building before 9:00 AM on Saturday will be eligible for awards.

**no vehicles will be allowed into the main
vending area after 8:00 AM daily.**

All vendors must have their vehicles in place
by **8:00 AM** each day.

You may leave the grounds at any time; however,
vehicle re-entry will not be permitted until after
5:00 PM, when the vending area begins to wind down.

If you plan to return during the day, please park in the
designated parking areas surrounding the fairgrounds
and walk into the event.

This policy is designed to improve pedestrian
traffic flow, reduce congestion, and
enhance safety throughout the event.

Lodging

At the Fairgrounds:

The fairgrounds are responsible for all camping at the fairgrounds and can be reached at:

For questions about camping or electrical service, please contact the Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds at (563) 326-5338.

Chief Blackhawk is not responsible for campground hookups or camping fees. Please direct all related questions to the Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds.

The Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds has a vendor fee for hooking up electrical service in your vending area, if electrical service is available. You can sign up for electrical service at the meet or let Vending Registration know ahead of time. Leave your name and space number at the registration table, and the fairgrounds will come around to your space to install electrical service if available.

The fairgrounds are responsible for electrical hookups. Vendors must be present at their space when the fairgrounds arrive to install electrical service.

Questions regarding availability and fees should be directed to fairgrounds personnel.



Storm Shelter Locations: In the event of a storm warning or other emergency, please refer to the meet map for storm shelter locations on the premises.



Please clean up after your pets or leave them at home. Exotic pets are not permitted. Dogs must remain on a leash at all times.



Local law enforcement will provide security throughout the grounds. If you need assistance, officers will be making regular rounds in golf carts, or you may visit Registration for assistance.

At West Lake:

West Lake, which is about three miles away, has multiple campgrounds. Information can be found here at:

Hotels/Motels:

All accommodations are a minimum of 3 miles from the fairgrounds. Walking is only practical if you are camping at the fairgrounds.

Because we are local to the area, we do not maintain hotel recommendations. Fortunately, the Quad Cities area is easy to navigate, and most destinations are within a short drive. Most locations in Iowa are within 15 minutes of the swap meet, while most locations on the Illinois side are within 25 minutes. Newer hotels can be found on Elmore Ave., and Utica Ridge in Davenport, IA.

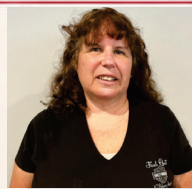

EXCITING NEWS!!

Chief Blackhawk is responding to requests for vending spaces in an area away from the frequent changes in Iowa weather. The IOWA BUILDING will continue to be inside vending along with Big BLUE. The Iowa Building and Big Blue are now open to all types of vendors! You are welcome to bring those parts and pieces you'd like to protect from the elements. Have that complete bike, or choice basket case? Got a fragile box of literature or original paint antique toy? We've got the space for you! Spaces will be 15 feet deep by 20 feet wide and there are plenty of them! As Big Blue & Iowa building are locked at night, there is no camping in vending spots. Vehicles will be allowed for unloading and loading only, but are not allowed to stay inside building. Spaces are reserved the same way as other swap meet spaces.

SWAP MEET VEHICLE POLICY

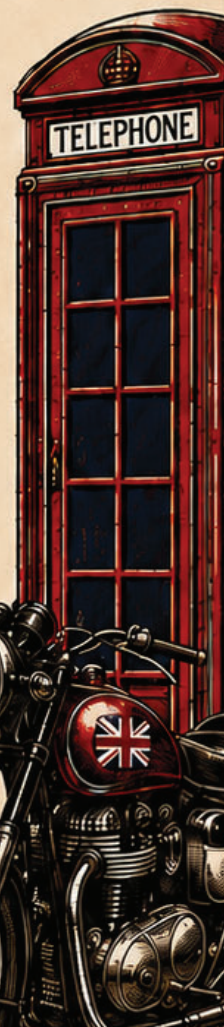
